New York Marathon : Fund raising for Eyesight charity

On November 7th this year Nick Luckock and Khawar Mann will be taking part in the New York Marathon. The marathon is one of the largest city races, with over 35,000 runners and two million spectators lining the course.

We will be running the marathon to raise funds for the Graham Layton Trust (<http://www.glt.org.uk>), a charity dedicated to preventing the suffering caused by blindness and other eye ailments in Pakistan by providing funds to the LRBT chain of free eye hospitals. For Nick, the marathon represents a shorter but hopefully faster course than the Caledonian Challenge (55 miles) from last year in which many of you generously supported the chosen charities.

There are over 2.5 million people in Pakistan rendered blind as a result of cataract, a condition that can be cured by a simple operation costing c. £15. For the many poor in the country, this is too large a sum to pay. Last year, over 61,000 eye surgeries were performed free of charge in the LRBT hospitals, providing almost 25% of all cataract surgeries in the country.

We are aiming to raise £10,000, which would restore the sight of more than 660 people. We would appreciate your support. Donations can be made as follows:
